CRITERIA FOR APPLICANT (REALTOR®) MEMBERSHIP IN THE YOUNGSTOWN COLUMBIANA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®

The following criteria for membership were developed by the Membership Committee of the National Association, to provide "reasonable and non-discriminatory written requirements for membership". The 6-point Criteria and explanatory notes as to their appropriate application have the approval of legal counsel, the National Association, and were approved by the Board of Directors of the National Association, in November, 1974 and amended in November, 1983 and 1990, and February, 1991.

An applicant for REALTOR® membership who is other than a sole proprietor, partner, or corporate officer of a real estate firm should supply satisfactory evidence that he/she has:

1. A VALID REAL ESTATE LICENSE (AND IS ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE REAL ESTATE BUSINESS AND ITS RECOGNIZED BRANCHES)

EXPLANATION: "A valid real estate license" is intended to mean that applicants for REALTOR® membership who are other than sole proprietors, partners, or corporate officers in a firm engaged in the real estate business must maintain a current, valid real estate broker's or salespersons license or must be licensed or certified by an appropriate state regulatory agency to engage in the appraisal of real property.

The term "actively engaged" in business contemplates that the licensed or certified applicants will have an office for the conduct of real estate business and shall hold themselves out to the public as being actively engaged in the real estate business, and shall actively seek and service real estate business. It does NOT contemplate that applicants must devote all or even a majority of their time to the real estate business or derive any particular percentage of their income from such business. It does NOT contemplate that applicant shall have no other employment or occupation.

Where questions arise as to whether or not applicants are "actively engaged" in the real estate business, they shall be given the opportunity to present evidence concerning the actual and intended scope of their business activities. In the event any applicant for membership is rejected on the basis of failure to be "actively engaged", the local Association should promptly seek a declaratory judgment from a court of competent jurisdiction affirming the propriety of such rejection.

2. EMPLOYED BY OR AFFILIATED WITH A REALTOR® AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR.

EXPLANATION: The basic qualification is employment or affiliation with a REALTOR®. The qualification is met by the individual regardless of whether they operate out of the principal office of the REALTOR® or a branch office.

3. MUST MAKE WRITTEN APPLICATION FOR REALTOR® MEMBERSHIP IN THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION. (Such application must be a voluntary act by the applicant, and cannot be a requirement of the local Association).

EXPLANATION: The local Association may not require that the salespersons affiliated with a REALTOR® be a Member of the Association. Neither can the Association require that the REALTOR® have such a requirement.

- 4. SIGNIFIED THEIR INTENTION TO ABIDE BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® CODE OF ETHICS.
- 5. SIGNIFIED THEIR INTENTION TO ABIDE BY THE CONSTITUTION, BYLAWS, POLICY AND RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION, THE STATE ASSOCIATION, AND THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®.

EXPLANATION: By such agreement in the application, the applicant assumes a continuing membership obligation.

6. COMPLETED THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION'S ORIENTATION COURSE.

EXPLANATION: It is presumed that the Orientation Class to be completed as a prerequisite to membership is confined to the subjects of the Constitution, Bylaws, Policies, Rules and Regulations of the Local Association, State Association, and the National Association as well as the Code of Ethics of the National Association. It is NOT contemplated that completion of an Orientation Class covering topics included in the licensing examination will be required for qualification.
